Resume of Clarinetist Jared Mundell

Mr. Mundell performs all of his solo repertoire from memory, including concertos by Francaix, Nielsen, Mozart, Weber, Spohr, Verdi and Hoffmeister. He originally studied with Deborah de Graaff, and later with John St George at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music/University of Sydney, where he graduated with a Bachelor of Music in performance. In 2007, Mr. Mundell came to the US where he was awarded a full scholarship to study under the tutelage of world renowned clarinetist, Hakan Rosengren. He has most recently completed his Masters of Music in performance with Professor Rosengren at California State University Fullerton, and while at the Sydney Conservatorium he was on the "Dean's List of Excellence in Performance" and was awarded two scholarships.

In 2007 Mr. Mundell gave a one hour solo broadcast across Australia for the Australian Broadcasting Corporation's "Rising Stars" program, was a radio finalist in the "Young Performer of the Year," and also had the honor of presenting a private performance for Richard Bonyngue. He is an experienced recitalist and concerto soloist who has given numerous solo performances around Australia. From 2005-2007, Mr. Mundell studied with other world renowned clarinet teachers in the United States and Israel including, David Shifrin, soloist and Professor at Yale, Mark Nuccio, Associate Principal Clarinet of the New York Philharmonic, Charles Neidich, soloist and Professor at the Juilliard School of Music, Larry Guy, Professor at New York University, and Ron Selka, Principal Clarinet of the Israeli Philharmonic Orchestra.

Mr. Mundell was a first prize winner in many Australian competitions, and was nominated for an encore performance at the Sydney Opera House. He was one of six (the only non-string) finalist in the recently opened and prestigious, Nelson Meers \$8000 "Outstanding Instrumentalists Scholarship," produced by the City of Sydney Cultural Council. In 2004, Mr. Mundell performed as principal clarinet in the Sydney Youth Orchestra's extensive tour of Italy, and in 2008, Mr Mundell performed as principal clarinet in the California State University Fullerton Symphony Orchestra's tour of Hungary, Slovakia, Poland, and the Czech Republic.
